

# For Fire Victims Relief and Shelter

**St. Cecilia's Lagunitas & St. Mary's Nicasio** are standing by to offer any assistance we can give. San Francisco Archdiocese is coordinating the relief effort directly with Catholic Charities and the City of Santa Rosa, and is in communication with Red Cross, Salvation Army and our local San Geronimo Valley Community Center (SGVCC).

In the event of an overflow of evacuees at SGVCC, St. Cecilia's parish hall will be used for backup. Our parish emergency shed supplies are available.

We are collecting donations for the fire victims currently housed at SGVCC.

The Archdiocese is working out the logistic of the effort and in the process of preparing for Parishes (preferably without a school) capable and available to provide comforting space for the following:

- a) Feeding Center
- b) Temporary Sleeping Center
- c) Reunification Center
- d) Spiritual Counseling
- e) Prayer – Meditation
- f) Resource Center
