Gospel: Lk 12:49-53

In Jewish thought, a fire is always the symbol of judgement, so when Jesus stated that in His Kingdom there will be a time of judgement. This was not a concept of Jewish theology. Judgement was for others but not the chosen people. The Jews firmly believe that God would judge other nations by one standard and themselves by another. The fact that a man was a Jew would be enough to absolve him of many things, since he is a member of the chosen race. However, Jesus eliminated this notion completely from his messianic message. His Gospel states that every man and woman will face judgement, therefore this is something a man cannot afford to put off, above all, making his peace with God. For the Jewish people, this was a whole new radical theology presented to them. Pharisees must have been abhorred. We also could live our lives thinking there is no judgement to come.
