Bethlehem, now called Beit Lahm, is a village in the territory of Zebulun, north-west of Nazareth. It was here the Israelite Judge Izban was born, close to Rachael's burial site, the village where Israel's most important king, David, was born. The village where Ruth and Boaz met in Bethlehem, a fortified village and from this village the Jews expected the Messiah, God's Holy One, would be born. Pilgrims continue to visit the Basilica of the Nativity, one of the most important churches in Christendom, the crypt in which Jesus was born, in the town of Bethlehem.
