### Universal Church

Pope Benedict XVI warned politicians against undermining the foundations of democracy in their fight against terrorism. "Terrorism is a serious problem whose perpetrators often claim to act in God's name and harbor an inexcusable contempt for human life," Countries have a right to defend themselves, "but this right must be exercised with complete respect for moral and legal norms. Pope Benedict questioned how a nation or group could claim to be protecting democracy "if we threaten its very foundations" by acting unconstitutionally.
