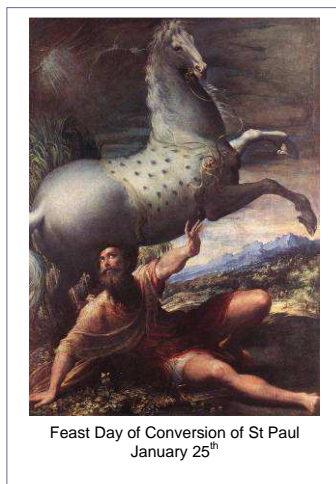
Gospel: Mark 1:14-20

The image of the fishermen with their nets, or mending their nets, or casting their nets, is a powerful image. Nets are the basic tool for a fisherman, without it he could not work or achieve his goals even if he had the best boat or crew in the business. The keeping of his nets is crucial to success. The apostolic mission or works, the work of the church is clearly seen in a similar light. Casting nets and mending them represent mission and maintenance, the twin arms of apostolate work, outreach to those not yet in Christ's net and routine maintenance of those who are already in. Actually when one thinks about it, much of the work of the church is maintenance, service to others.
