Universal Church

The Shroud of Turin was hidden in a Benedictine abbey during World War II in part because Church authorities feared Adolf Hitler might want to steal it, a monastery official told an Italian magazine. The shroud was transferred in 1939 to the abbey of Montevergine in southern Italy and was returned to Turin in 1946. Hitler was thought by some to have been obsessed about objects related to Christ.

Visitations to the Shroud are now closed to visitors. Last week, at the Novena for Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Augustine Pham, a parishioner from St. Isabella's, brought back a replica of the shroud and prayer cards for the Carmelite Sisters from Turin, Italy.
