In Chile, some 80,000 young people joined in the 20th Youth Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Teresa of the Andes to thank God for the rescue of the 33 miners trapped for 69 days in the San Jose mine. A young Chilean gave a Chilean flag signed by the 33 miners to Pope Benedict XVI at a general audience. Pope Benedict subsequently took it home and displayed it as a reminder of the men's plight and their need for prayer. During the ordeal, Pope Benedict sent each man a rosary which was brought to the mine by the Archbishop of Santiago. In reflection of their faith, one miner said, "I was with God, and with the Devil -- and God took me."
