The recognition of Christ as a King had everything to do with his execution and the reason why the earliest Jews left Judaism and became Christian, that Christ claimed He was God was unacceptable to Judaism, that He changed Judaic Laws equally was unacceptable, since God made the law, Christ by changing laws was making himself a God. Only God could change the laws He made. Therefore, no man could touch them. Christ as King shattered these two Jewish premises.

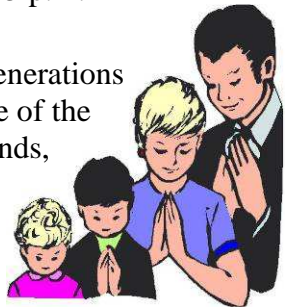
