

Minimum Wage The Federal minimum wage remains at \$7.25 an hour, just \$15,000 a year for a full-time worker. Two-thirds of Americans favor increasing the minimum wage to \$10.00 an hour. The Catholic Church has supported for decades a living wage, it's the best way out of poverty, to have a reasonable wage for work. In 2011, eight states raised their minimum wage levels. All work should be valued by decent wages to support families sustain themselves. \*\*\*
