Catechetics

Do penitents at Confession have to receive a penance for sins? The priest is required to give a penance to penitents as a part of the sacrament. If the penitent thinks the penance is too harsh, he can ask the priest if he would lessen it. If the penitent refuses penance then he lacks sorrow & contrition and forgiveness of the sacrament. By this unrepentant attitude he continues to live in sin. The only exception to no penance required is if the penitent is near death.

Top 5 Animals of the Bible are:

- Sheep: Because of the important symbol of the shepherd.
- <u>Lamb</u>: The blood of the Passover lamb saving the first born and Christ's blood saving us.
- <u>Donkey</u>: At Christ's birth and triumphal entrance into Jerusalem, the donkey is shown as willing to serve.
- <u>Calf</u>: Fattening a calf takes time and care.
 He was destined to be slaughtered for special meals as the Prodigal Son story.
- Snake: Symbol for evil, death & disobedience, as in the Garden of Eden story.
