





2013 Town Hall Meeting:

Last week's meeting focus: Finance, Parish Life, and Spirituality. Recap as follows:



- +Goal of Weekly Collections SC \$700, SM\$500. Support parish fund raisers. These cover operating cost of a parish to be viable and financially independent. Fund Raisers: SC – Golf Tournament, Columbus Day Dinner, Rummage Sale, 100th Anniversary glassware; SM – Palm Sunday Brunch, Christmas Concert;
- +2013 AAA assessment for SC\$ 6.400. SM \$5.100:
- **★**Each year, Archdiocese requires every parish to report back Safety/Maintenance Checkup. St. Cecilia/St. Mary maintenance team will start the inspection soon;
- → Repair of Parish Hall Roof in the summer;
- ♦ Use of ladder: Archdiocese's policy emphasizes that no one is allowed to go up a ladder alone on church properties, to ensure the safety of the persons;
- → Use Sign-Out Sheets for borrowing tables/chairs/etc. from parish hall. Also check with Fr. in case of event conflict;
- → Event teams responsible for clean up and put things back where they are; (e.g. ashes BBQ grill, glassware);
- **→** Garden Cleanup Day Volunteers need;
- → Parishioners are asked to support at least 5 parish events every year. Lots of work & planning involved;
- → Parish Goal: Last year was "Catechism" (continue improvements where necessary). This year is "Social Justice". We'll share ideas & thoughts during the year;
- → Fr.'d like to form a Choir (members from both parishes) to enhance the Liturgy. Need commitment & interest;
- → We will conduct our own retreat this year Stinson Beach;
- → Parish book of the year: "What Happened at Vatican II" 2012 was the 50th Anniversary of Vatican II. Book review first 200 pages in July, second part in Advent;
- → Mass Intentions encouraged Catholic tradition for community to come together to pray for the intention;

- **★** Sister Parish Committee formed:
- → Additions: SC bulletin board easel, SM sanctuary chair;

Parishioners' Feedbacks:

- → Archbishop's visit to every parish: St. Cecilia/St. Mary to get our thoughts together. Summarize & strategize before presenting them to the Archbishop when he comes;
- **→** Create a Master Calendar scheduling for people to sign up to take care of things that needs to be done (e.g. Christmas lights, coffee/donut, etc.) Persons in charge need to be on top and follow-up;
- **+**2-3 week advance notice in bulletin for garden cleanup or book review;
- → Publish Parish Directory;
- **→** Support AAA for the Archdiocesan level of service and operation;
- **♦** CCD classroom for kids needs to be tidy up after use:
- **★**Evangelization around the parish. Need a push to encourage people be actively involved; not just attending Masses.

Fr. in conclusion: We are a 100% volunteer parish. We all rise up to the occasion and do it. Something beautiful about volunteer parish as we have a marvelous community together. It is wonderful for St. Cecilia & St. Mary to come together once a year for the Town Hall Meeting.
