Pope Francis I – Part 2 of 3 His father was a railway worker. He studied in public schools. At 12 years he said to Damote, "If I cannot marry you, I will become a priest." Damote still lives in the same neighborhood. At 21 years he lost partially his right lung due to severe pneumonia. During Argentina Military dictatorships, '76-83, where 30,000 people were murdered or disappeared, he apologized for the church's silence and his own. 130 priests were martyred. The official church never made a claim for them, or vociferously stood with them. Much later the bishops admitted "They had not done enough at the time." When the church does not have its boots on the ground with the people, its message is lifeless and boneless. Fortunately courageous priests made a difference.
