Pope Francis I

When Pope Francis became an Archbishop 6/3/1997, he did not introduce himself through the media or national journalists. Instead he chose a humble parish bulletin to introduce himself. When elected as Pope, he took the bus back to his hotel instead of using the papal limousine. He quickly has cast aside monarchical Papal expectations and customs extravagance, instead choosing spontaneity simplicity and present amongst the people. He does not want a private secretary, or papal condo's. As Archbishop, he regularly visited slumps, he is known by his people as the "Slanty Town Pope". He is not a liberal, but an evangelizer. He puts Christ at the center of the church, not power. The Church would have no reason to exist only for Christ. He shocked faces of the Roman Curia, courtiers must be rocking at what is happening.
