With traditional marriage now redefined, the Courts can inevitably support other relationships as polygamy, polyamorous on the basis of rights. The Church will begin to examine whether civil marriage and sacramental marriage should be intertwined. Sacramental marriage in order to distinguish its values on marriage may relinquish signing of the civil license at a sacramental wedding, and the civil signing take place at another time and place. Catholics will be asked to clearly define and understand what marriage is, monogamy, permanence and children and defend it in the public square.
