Vatican News

Archbishop Pietro Parolin, appointed by Pope Francis as Vatican Secretary of State, will run the Curia and be second closest to the Pope in Vatican affairs. He will be responsible for the reorganizing of the Vatican Government which Pope Francis 1st intends to restructure. He will be made Cardinal in October.

Pope Francis has appointed a 5-person panel to review Vatican Bank activities. Suspicious transactions have forced a number of resignations and arrests. More transparency and accountability is demanded today by the international banks, therefore renouncing the Vatican Bank traditional secrecy. The Vatican Bank was established in 1942 by Pope Pius XII. Its purpose is to hold and move funds for works of Catholic Charity and humanitarian projects. It has a balance sheet of \$6.04 billion. It employs 112 people. It has no shareholders.
