Pope Francis in his own words (Part 4)

I am the first Pontiff from a religious order since 1831. Religious men and women are meant to be prophets. Their vows open them up for this. They should make waves, stir the pot up, make noise, an uproar, cause a mess, challenge the status quo.

What is your view of the Roman Curia?

The Church needs a Curia. We cannot function without one. There are many dedicated men and women involved in curial work. But they are not the center of the Church, but in the service of Mother Church. We also have the faith of collegiality. This too must be respected. We must walk together, the people, the bishops, and the Pope. Even the Pope should be collegial, and he would like the laity to have more of a role in the Curia.
