The Council of Trent 1563 has reached its 450th year. It was opened in response to the Protestant Reformation and Martin Luther's 95 theses nailed to the church door at Wittenburg. Only a couple of dozen Bishops attended, mostly Italian. Pope Paul III did not attend. Trent countered Luther by saying:

- 1. Faith is not only Scripture but also Tradition
- 2. There are seven sacraments not one. Luther: only Baptism
- 3. God's Grace to be evident in Good Works. Luther: works not required for salvation
- 4. Eucharist is the real presence (transubstantiation) not symbolic
- 5. Bishops and Pastors to reside in their territories
- 6. Priestly celibacy reaffirmed
- 7. Established Seminaries to educate priests
- 8. The Mass should be celebrated in Latin
- 9. It created a Catechism
- 10. The Confessional was introduced into church architecture
- 11. A priest has to be present for a Catholic wedding
- 12. The church affirmed five books of Scripture which Luther throw out as not divinely inspired.

All in all, Trent made a huge impact in the history of the Catholic Church in ways of cohesion and stability. Everybody knew what Catholicism is.
