Universal Church

- Pope Francis with his council and advisory groups has decided the Vatican Bank will continue to function but will be held to international accountability transparency standards.
- The sexual scandal within the church is still a very sensitive issue. But the good news since implementing zero tolerance is, 2013 10 instances of abuse in the United States is reported as credible allegations against minor. All employees of the church are trained today in safe environment children safety.
- From 1960 to 2012, those who marry in the church have dropped from 68% to 53%. Birth rate has dropped 24% to 12%. Unmarried mothers skyrocketed from 29% to 53%. Baptisms have dropped 25% and Confirmations 60%. None of this happened overnight. Over the decades there has been a gradual decline of church discipline and faith practice.
