Catholic Social Teaching on the Rights of Workers is clear and consistent. Laborers have the right to unions that defend their rights. One million workers are employed by the Catholic Church in America, yet not all Catholic institutions tolerate unions for their workers despite Catholic Social teaching as a fundamental moral principle we hold to. They state our religious mission is our highest priority and cannot be bargained away by unions, lawyers, and collective bargaining. When a Catholic institution fails to respect worker's rights, it run the risk of suggesting these principles do not count and loses its moral voice. As one Catholic university student said, "How can we support the rights of steel workers, farm workers, etc. if we don't support the rights of our own." It is fair to say we are improving, and have come a long way since the '80s.
