### Pope Francis U.S. Tour His challenges are:

1. Free-market capitalism. Wealth has to be shared. The poor cannot be left out. The common good is America's best tradition, the middle class;
2. Immigrants. We are all foreigners. We should not fear the newest wave hoping to have a better life.
3. Religious Freedom. No one should threaten religious freedom. Religious freedom is the right to speak in the public square and oppose absolute totalitarianism.
4. Environment. Nations need to take concrete steps to reduce climate problems. This is a moral imperative for future generations.
5. Family. Needs to be restored and supported by civil institutions. In our culture, relationships are mere means for the satisfaction of one's needs.

**Junipero Serra** (Part 11 of 15) The Indians admired the Virgin of Guadalupe, but were alarmed at the crucified Christ on the cross. The Indians continued their ways of polygamy, adultery, witchcraft and other sinful scandals. The Franciscans responded with punishments. It will take decades of evangelizing before Christianity will produce spiritual fruits. 1752 Serra was appointed inquisitor by the inquisition. He was to investigate sorcery and heretical acts in Sierra Gorda. Two incidents as an agent of the inquisition investigating heretics would tarnish his name.
