**Junipero Serra** (Part 13 of 15) The relocation of Indians from roaming lands to settlements caused great harm, their way of life taken and the spread of European diseases. There was no bishop in the regions. Finally January 1769, Serra was granted to move into upper California (Alta California). Three ships sailed to San Diego with supplies & goods. Serra with a mule train walked the 700 miles to San Diego. And so the 1<sup>st</sup> immigrant into upper CA arrived, Junipero Serra.
