**Baptismal Font** The font is in every Catholic Church placed at entrance of the church or by sanctuary. In the early church baptisms took place outdoors in rivers, streams, public bath, wells. When churches were built in the 4<sup>th</sup> century, Baptism were brought indoors and have remained since. One font is allowed in the church symbolizing one Faith, one Christ, one Church we all share in.
