Martyred Oscar Romero (Part 2 of 3)
Archbishop Romero was not a revolutionary, but he was devoted to the poor. His people were being murdered by the government including priests, churches destroyed, bombings of radio stations, etc. In his Cathedral, he preached against the people of power. People couldn't believe it, finally a powerful voice stood with them. The truth of government violence was told in the Cathedral.

Godparents (Part 1 of 3) The choosing of Godparents can lead to hurt feelings and disappointments as some people think "I should have been asked to be a Godparent." In some cultures, it is a big deal. Choosing Godparents is like adding to the family. No one expects a Godparent to be teaching theology to their Godchild, but they do expect they take an interest in their Godchild.
