Here is some good news for us. God loves us even though we are sinners. God welcomes repentant sinners, and mercifully forgives all our sins. God's merciful love and forgiveness encourages our conversion, renewal of life, and generous giving.

Although God rebukes the offenders, warns them of their sins and reminds them to abandon their wickedness (Wis.12:2), he is indeed kind and merciful to all, slow to anger and rich in kindness (Ps. 148:8). God continues to love us even when we are not faithful. He patiently gives us time for repentance.

St. Paul encourages us to persevere in faith, giving glory to God, living a good Christian life every day, allowing God to work through our lives so that we may be worthy of our vocation as Christians ( $2^{nd}$  reading). (cont.)

Jesus invites each one of us to total conversion, to move from our feeble faith to a more powerful faith. We are called to be generous financially and spiritually, too.

Let us admit our sinfulness and accept God's call to repentance, conversion and renewal of life.


